



# Year Three - Autumn Curriculum overview



## Topic overview

This term Year 3 children will learn all about Animals and skeletons. Their topic will focus on identifying that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat, as well as identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

## Core subjects

**Maths** – Children will explore multiplication and division and understanding the relationship between both operations. Additionally, they will be introduced to fractions where they will understand a unit and no-unit fraction, simple equivalent fractions and fractions of a shape and amount.

**English** – Children will be introduced to a range of texts which will inform their writing, such as narratives and poetry. In addition, we will be continuing our reading of more challenging texts and answer questions relating to what they have read.

**Science** – Y3 will focus on identifying that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat, as well as identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.
