


## E-reading platform




Once logged in select start browsing to view thousands of titles.


### 4. Loneliness


If you right click and drag over a word, you can highlight it, find the meaning of the word or add your own notes.

If you choose to save this you can access it later through the bookmark tab.

To change any settings such as background colour, font size etc. click on the cog. If you scroll to the bottom of the page there are suggestions to make the text more dyslexia friendly.
