

Year Five - Autumn Curriculum Overview



Topic overview

This term in Year 5, the children will be learning about natural disasters, including volcanoes and earthquakes. They will learn about the causes and effects of natural disasters and write eye-witness accounts. Taking inspiration from Bear Grylls, Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo, the children will create their own survival guides and learn survival skills. They will also be learning about forces in science.

Core subjects

Maths - Children will be consolidating and deepening their knowledge of place value and the four operations. They will also be developing their problem solving and reasoning skills.

English – The children will start the year writing a survival narrative based on real-life stories as told in the book *Survivors*. They will then write a new chapter of *Kensuke's Kingdom* in the style of the author, Michael Morpurgo. Following this, the children will explore how to survive on a desert island and will write survival guides, which will build on their understanding of sentence and paragraph structure.

Science – Children will be learning about properties and changes of materials, looking at reversible and irreversible changes. As part of their forces topic, children will investigate air resistance by conducting an in-depth experiment involving paper helicopters.
