



# Year Five - Autumn Curriculum Overview



## Topic overview

This term in Year 5, the children will be learning about natural disasters, including volcanoes and earthquakes. They will learn about the causes and effects of natural disasters and use their teamwork skills to survive a disaster zone. Taking inspiration from Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo, the children will create their own survival narrative. They will also be learning about forces in science.

## Core subjects

**Maths** - Children will be consolidating and deepening their knowledge of place value and the four operations. They will also be developing their problem solving and reasoning skills.

**English** – The children will start the year diving into *Kensuke's Kingdom*, written by Michael Morpurgo, and use their reading skills to develop a deep understanding of the text. They will then create their own chapter in the style of the author. Following this, the children will explore how to survive on a desert island and will write survival guides, which will build on their understanding of sentence and paragraph structure.

**Science** – Children will be learning about properties and changes of materials, looking at reversible and irreversible changes. As part of their forces topic, children will explore air resistance by planning and conducting their own investigation.

**Art and DT** – Children will be linking their learning in R.E to Art by creating Rangoli patterns.

**Geography** – Children will be learning about what causes natural disasters and developing their map skills.
